Super Minds Level 3 Unit 6 Gadgets and Unit 7 In the hospital

In April we will finish Unit 6. Children will take a quiz (small test) about the comparative and superlative forms of adjectives.

In Unit 7 they will learn about health and sicknesses. They will learn the past tense of regular verbs and some irregular verbs.

We will plant some flowers and some vegetables and monitor their growth throughout the month.

Please note that in April there will be two shorter tests and in May there will be one longer test which will review what we have been learning throughout the year.

Grammar

- Review: past tense of “to be” : was/were
- Review: comparative and superlative (big, bigger, biggest; cheap, cheaper, cheapest; more expensive, most expensive; less expensive, least expensive)
- New: Simple past tense
 - regular verbs (infinitive form + ed): jumped, landed, looked at, shouted, played, listened
 - irregular verbs: have → had, ride → rode, eat → ate, wake up → woke up, feel → felt, go → went, give → gave, say → said, write → wrote

Vocabulary

- Review: gadgets
- New:
 - health: earache, headache, cold, toothache, stomach-ache, cough, doctor, nurse, dentist, ill, get better, what’s the matter
 - verbs (see grammar above)
