Super Minds Level 3 Unit 8 Around the World

In May we will work on Unit 8, Around the World. The main grammar topic is the past tense - negative and questions in the past. We will also work on asking and answering different types of questions.

We will learn about different countries.

We will write our own song and sing it.

We will have a test to review the comparative and the simple past, and test on Unit 8 but also material from earlier chapters (review).

Grammar

- Review:
 - simple past of “to be”: was/were, were you? was he/she? Yes, he was. No, she wasn’t.
 - simple past of common regular and irregular verbs
 - comparative and superlative (big, bigger, biggest; cheap, cheaper, cheapest; more expensive, most expensive; less expensive, least expensive)
- New: the simple past - negative
 - I didn’t see the lions. We didn’t have fun.
- New: the simple past - questions
 - Did you see the lions?

Vocabulary

- Review: health, verbs in the past
- Countries and travel: Mexico, Egypt, Chile, China, Spain, Argentina, India, Australia, Turkey, Brazil, idea, ticket, visit, change, buy, travel, postcard, stay, send, forget, not yet, I’m not sure, on holiday, cottage, beach, mountain, forest, pyramid
