Super Minds 4 - Unit 3 Danger!

The themes of Unit 3 are emergencies and accidents. Ben, Lucy and Ben's grandfather come across a car accident. The grandfather helps a man from the car and Lucy calls emergency services. They read a story about a Tsunami in Thailand. Children learn the past continuous tense - how it is formed and how it is used. They make an escape plan for their school.

Grammar

- The past continuous tense = was/were + verb in -ing

- I was running.
- You weren't driving very fast.
- Were they singing?
- What were you doing yesterday?
- Who was running?

Review: the present continuous tense (when it is used, how it is formed)

Vocabulary

- Emergency: fire, flood, emergency services, police car, police officer, fire engine, firefighter, ambulance, paramedic, accident, careful, save (a life), feel (hungry, tired), safe, danger, dangerous

- Review: verbs
