Super Minds 4 - Unit 2 The World Around Us

The themes of Unit 2 are the countryside and food (at a restaurant). Ben and Lucy go for a walk with their grandfather and go to a museum, where they find the next clue. Children learn conjunctions (spojky) and the past tense of the verb *can*. They learn about some famous paintings in English and make a collage. They speak about free time.

Grammar

- The past tense of the verb *can*-positive, negative and questions = "could", "couldn't", "Could you..."?
 - I **could** jump higher than a tree when I was young.
 - I **couldn't** run 20 kilometres.
 - **Could you** swim in the sea?
- Review: **comparative** (older than, more famous than) and **superlative** (the oldest, the most famous) of adjectives
- Continued review: the simple past of common verbs (regular and irregular)

Vocabulary

- countryside: mountain, forest, village, lake, island, field, river, path, stream, beach, seaside, rucksack (bag), outdoors, inside
- conjunctions (spojky): and, but, because, so
- Review: verbs
