Super Minds 4 - Unit 1 In the Museum

The themes of Unit 1 are museums, rules, the world of kings and queens and clothing accessories. Ben and Lucy go to a museum, are chased by a knight and find the first clue in their map. Children learn the modal verb "must" and "mustn't" and review imperatives. They also learn about subject and object pronouns. The new vocabulary is words related to kings and queens, clothing accessories and some new verbs. Children will have a presentation about a museum or gallery they have visited.

Grammar

- The verb "must" and "mustn't"
 - I must do my homework.
 - I mustn't come late to class.
- The imperative: Give me the necklace, please. Don't give the map to me.
- Subject and Object Pronouns. I want the necklace. Give me the necklace. Give the necklace to me.
- Review: comparative (older than, more famous than) and superlative (the oldest, the most famous) of adjectives

Vocabulary

- Museums: knight, queen, crown, helmet, necklace, bracelet, belt, shield, bow and arrow, sword, statue, vase, symbol
- Rules: touch, take photos, shout, fight, leave, keep, put
