l. Print the template. If printing the black and white one, color it first.




4. Fold along the dashed lines.



7. Draw or stick a photo inside a circle on the background. Apply glue on the spaces marked with the word glue.



10. Apply glue on one end of the small paper strip and glue it into a loop.



2. Cut out the rocket, moon, small rectangle and optionally rectangle with text.



5. Fold the fins up.



8. Stick the rocket on the template. Be careful to leave the fins on the outside.



II. Stick the loop inside the circle on the background.



3. Cut along the full lines on exhaust flames. Cut out the inside circle (window).



6. Fold along the dashed lines on the exhaust flames (accordion).



9. Stick the rectangle with the text inside the rectangle on the background or write in your own text.



I2. Apply glue on the top of the paper loop and stick the moon on it.
